

GUIDELINES BELGIAN CHAMPINSHIPS MASTERS 2025 KORTRIJK – 22 and 23 November 2025

POOL ACCES / CHANGING ROOMS / STANDS

Swimmers, trainers and delegates access the pool through the entrance gates next to the reception desk at Lago Kortrijk Weide. Via the stairs, they make their way to the group changing rooms (down the stairs to the right, then to the right again), which are divided by gender. Changing rooms 3 to 8 are reserved for the ladies, changing rooms 10 to 15 for the men. Changing rooms 1 and 2 are reserved for the doping control. The changing rooms, swimming pool and stands can be used as rest areas.

CHANGING ROOMS, WARMING UP, DRESS CODE TRAINERS AND DELEGATES

Swimmers can change in the provided changing rooms. There are lockers on the way to the pool, for which a €1 coin must be used! We ask that you only bring the necessary equipment to the pool. It is not allowed to eat in the pool.

Swim-in schedule on Saturday and Sunday:

- AM from 07h45 until 08h45 – PM from 12h45 until 13h45 (subject to change)

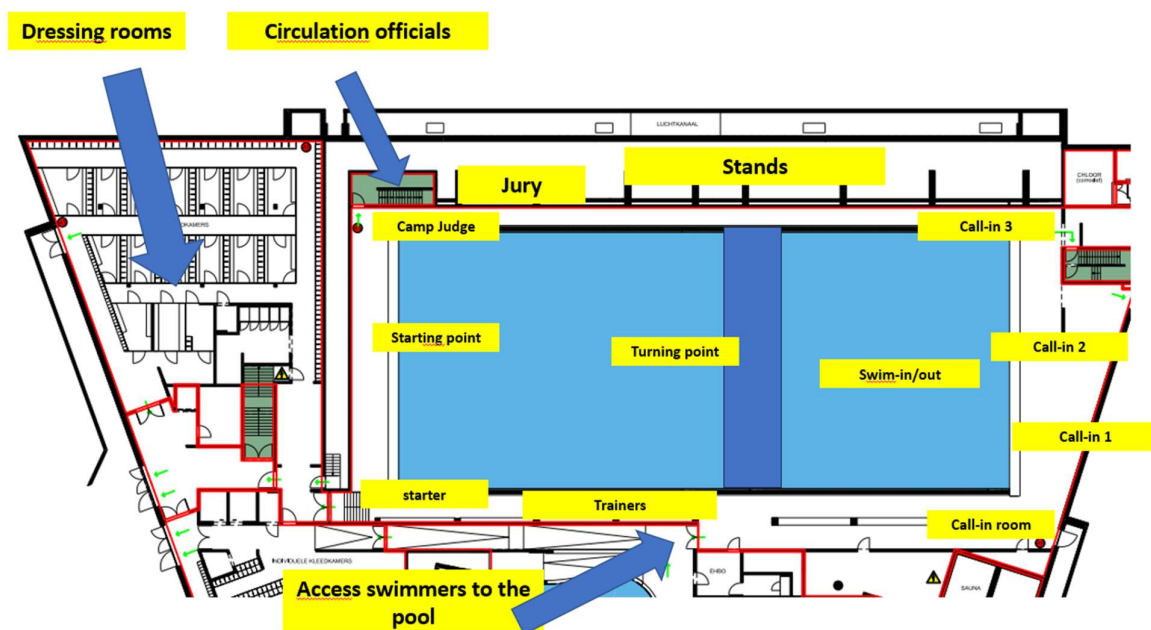
Start of the competition

- AM from 09h00 and PM from 14h00 (subject to change)

Swimmers will access the pool via the subtropical leisure pool corridor, not via the steps leading directly to the pool.

The call-in room will be on the opposite side of the pool (railway side), then several consecutive call-in rooms will be provided. Swimmers should report in time for their race.

Trainers and delegates must wear sporting attire in the pool: shorts or training trousers as well as a shirt of their own club. City clothes will not be tolerated in the pool!

ACCES PUBLIC

The public will have free access to the grandstand. Programmes are available online only.

MEDALS

All medals will be collected in an envelope per club and handed over to each club's delegate at the end of each competition day.

CATERING

The Lago Bistro will have a stand next to the lounge, where spaghetti or pasta cheese & ham can be purchased at the price of €10.00 per serving. A token must be purchased in advance at the KZK cash desk.

OFFICIALS

Officials are granted access based on the pre-made list. They make their way to the first floor, where there is a special room for them. We ask that to the extent possible they already have the white attire and appropriate footwear on.

The official area will be closed during the match.

KZK will provide breakfast cakes in the morning, during the lunch break each official will get a pasta meal. Coffee and water will also be provided to the officials. All officials can enjoy these for free.

BEWARE OF FINES!

It is forbidden to drive your car up to Lago Kortrijk Weide without a transit ticket, so watch out for this. Unless you want to fund Kortrijk's city coffers....
