

GUIDELINES FOR THE BELGIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS MASTERS 2026 KORTRIJK – 20 and 21 June 2026

ACCESS TO THE SWIMMING POOL / CHANGING ROOMS / SPECTATOR STANDS

Swimmers, coaches and officials can access the swimming pool via the entrance gates next to the reception at Lago Kortrijk Weide. They can reach the group changing rooms via the stairs (turn right at the bottom of the stairs, then right again), which are separated by gender. Changing rooms 3 to 8 are reserved for women, and changing rooms 10 to 15 for men. Changing rooms 1 and 2 are reserved for doping control. The changing rooms, the swimming pool and the stands may be used as rest areas.

CHANGING ROOMS, WARM-UP, DRESS CODE FOR COACHES AND DELEGATES

Swimmers can get changed in the changing rooms provided. There are lockers on the way to the swimming pool, which require a 1-euro coin! We ask that you only bring essential items to the swimming pool. Eating is not permitted in the swimming pool.

Swimming schedule on Saturdays and Sundays:

- Morning from 07:45 to 08:45 – Afternoon from 12:45 to 13:45

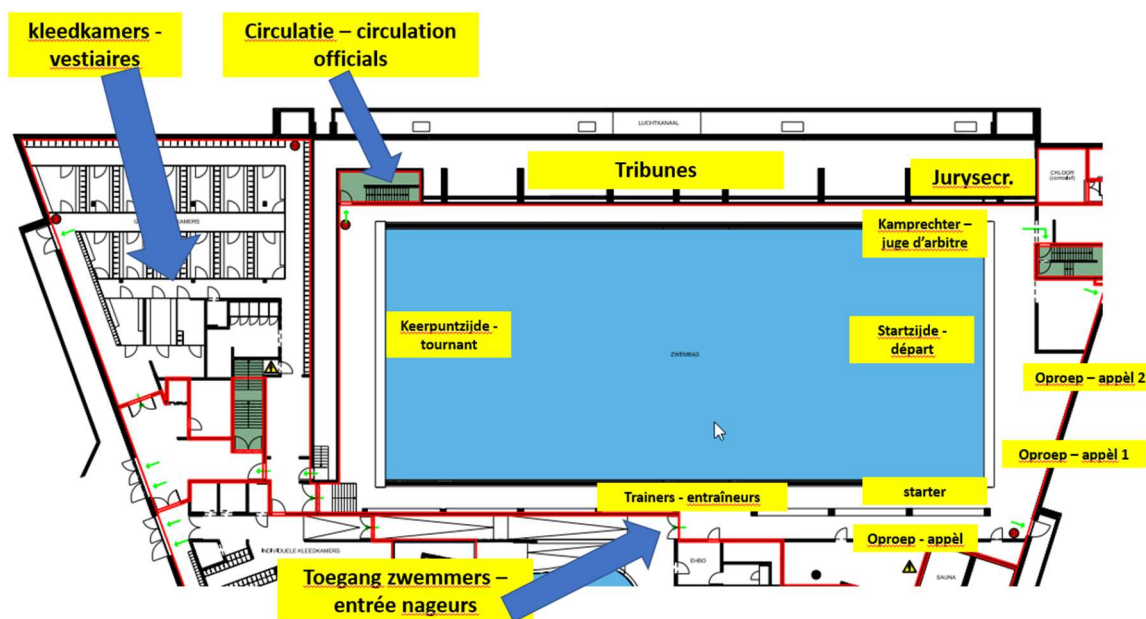
Start of the competitions

- Morning at 09:00 and Afternoon at 14:00

Swimmers will access the pool via the corridor leading to the subtropical leisure pool, not via the steps leading directly to the pool.

The call room will be located on the opposite side of the pool (railway side), followed by a number of additional call rooms. Swimmers must report in good time before their race.

Coaches and officials must wear sportswear in the pool: shorts or tracksuit bottoms and a shirt from their own club. Street clothes will not be tolerated in the pool!



PUBLIC ACCESS

Admission to the stands is free. Programmes are available in digital format only!

MEDALS / CERTIFICATES

The medals will be handed out after each race at the (new) counter. This will be located near the entrance to the stands. Each swimmer or the club representative should collect the medals from this counter. The medals will therefore no longer be placed in envelopes!

In addition, the certificates for the winners (Belgian Champions) of each race will also be available/printed on the spot: each swimmer or the club representative can collect these certificates at the entrance to the stands.

CATERING

In the Lago Bistro, there is a stall next to the lounge where you can buy spaghetti or pasta cheese/ham for €12.00 per portion. You must purchase a token in advance at the KZK ticket office.

OFFICIALS

Officials will be granted access based on the pre-compiled list. They should proceed to the first floor, where a special area has been set aside for them. We ask that, where possible, they already be wearing appropriate clothing and footwear.

The officials' area will be closed during the competition.

KZK provides breakfast biscuits in the morning, and during the lunch break, every official is given a pasta meal. Coffee and water are also provided for the officials. All officials can enjoy these free of charge.

BEWARE OF (GAS) FINES!

It is forbidden to drive to Lago Kortrijk Weide without a pass, so please be aware of this. Unless, of course, you want to line the coffers of Kortrijk City Council...
