



## CIVE 2024 Information

### 1. Time schedule

The start time of the sessions are as follows:

- Session 1 of Saturday: start time = 13h30
- Session 2 of Sunday: start time = 9h00
- Team Leader Meeting on Saturday @12h30 in the Cafeteria
- Officials Meeting on Saturday @12h30 in the room behind the Cafeteria
- Officials Meeting on Sunday @ 8h00
- Warm up times – 3 slots (mixed, men only, women only) – please check time schedule for details

### 2. Entries

We have received entries of swimmers with entry times slower than the considered entry time. We have accepted all swimmers as the overall number of entries and the time schedule allow us this year to accept everybody.

### 3. Withdrawal deadlines for absent swimmers are as follows:

For Session 1 = latest Friday 14h00 by email to [mireillezimmer.scde@gmail.com](mailto:mireillezimmer.scde@gmail.com) and [max@beckers.lu](mailto:max@beckers.lu). The start list for Saturday will be emailed to you before 18h00 on Friday so that you can print it before coming to the competition on Saturday.

For Session 2 = latest by Saturday 17h00 via email or at the referee table. The start list will be emailed to you and we will have copies of the start lists available for you on Sunday morning for the teams that stay overnight in Ettelbruck.

Withdrawals from Finals: Any finalist or reserve for a final who does not wish to swim in a Final must complete a withdrawal form and submit it to the referee table at the latest 30 minutes after the results of the preliminary heats of the event are published. Failure to comply with this procedure will result in a fine of € 50.

### 4. Startlists: will only be available online and not on paper for spectators. Start lists and live results are available on [www.scde.lu](http://www.scde.lu).

### 5. Lunch for Saturday and Sunday: please order your lunches at the latest by Wednesday noon via email to [mireillezimmer.scde@gmail.com](mailto:mireillezimmer.scde@gmail.com) (if not already done).

### 6. The Cafeteria is located in the school building opposite to the swimming pool. Lunch will be served there.

### 7. Medal ceremonies: all medal ceremonies will take place after the end of session 1 and session 3 in the Cafeteria. A detailed timeline for the ceremonies for Saturday and Sunday will be sent to you later this week. Please ensure that your swimmers are ready in the cafeteria at the scheduled time. The victory ceremonies are part of the competition. Medals and prizes are not handed out if the swimmer is not present at the ceremony.

### 8. Athletes seating and pool access

Athletes will be seated in the sports hall next to the swimming pool. Please do not forget to bring your own chairs and depending on the weather, warm clothes as it might be cold in the sports hall. Swimmers and coaches will not be allowed to take any bags into the swimming pool.

The call room is located in the women's changing room. A TV screen with livestream will be installed in the call room and there is direct access to toilets in the call room.

To watch swimming, athletes and coaches can access the pool deck exclusively through the men's changing room. After their races swimmers will leave the pool deck along the window side to go back to the sports hall. Changing rooms and showers for athletes are available next to the sports hall.
